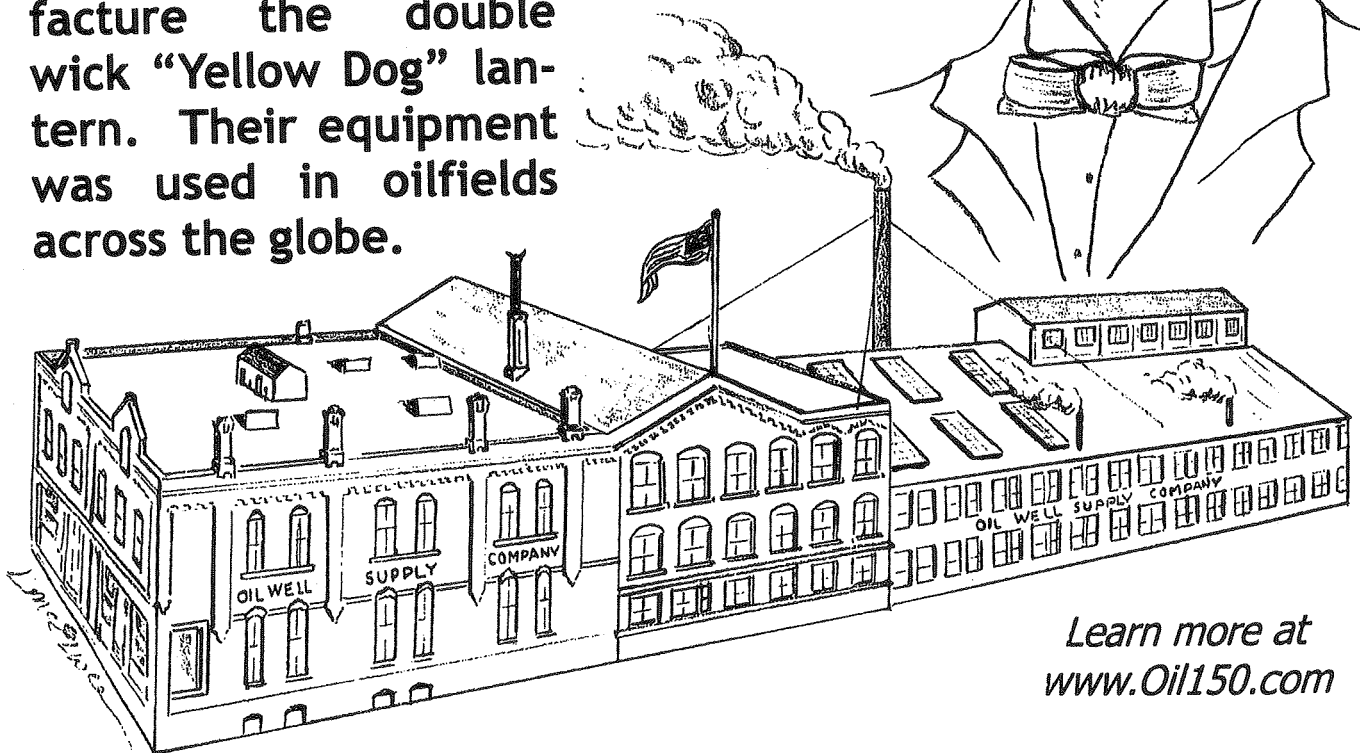
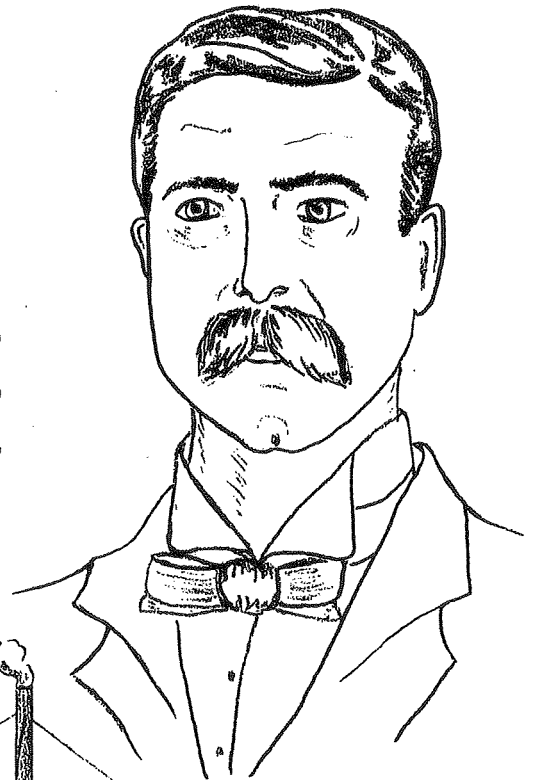


Pioneering Petroleum...

JOHN EATON

John Eaton entered the oil well supply business in 1861. He started his own business in 1867. By 1869, he partnered with E. H. Cole in a firm called Eaton & Cole. In 1878, the Oil Well Supply Company, Limited was formed as a partnership that combined several rivals including Eaton's company. Oil Well Supply Company was incorporated in 1891 with Eaton as its President. In 1898, the firm had principal plants in Pittsburgh, Oil City and Bradford.

From Standard Derrick kits to valves, engines, boilers and pipe, Oil Well Supply manufactured goods and distributed items needed within the oil industry. Meeting every need, the firm even held the rights to manufacture the double wick "Yellow Dog" lantern. Their equipment was used in oilfields across the globe.
