As part of its mission to encourage communities outside of Pennsylvania's Oil Heritage Region to celebrate the 150th anniversary of Drake Well and the birth of the U.S. petroleum industry, Oil 150, in conjunction with the Oil Region Alliance of Business, Industry & Tourism, has organized a traveling exhibit entitled "Oil and the Pennsylvania Valley that changed the World." Featuring dozens of photos of the various stages of the western Pennsylvania Oil Boom, the exhibit includes text and visuals that briefly tell the story of how the world's oil industry began. Funded by a DCNR Pennsylvania Heritage Grant with additional funding by the Pennsylvania Humanities Council, the exhibit is **free of charge** and available to museums, historical organizations, and libraries wishing to host it at an indoor location for one month. It can be delivered to your site

and set up by us in an hour or two. Its dimensions are 16' wide, 8' tall, and about 2' deep. It is free-standing and requires no electricity. The only maintenance required is replenishing of brochure pockets. To arrange for hosting the exhibit at your location, please contact:
